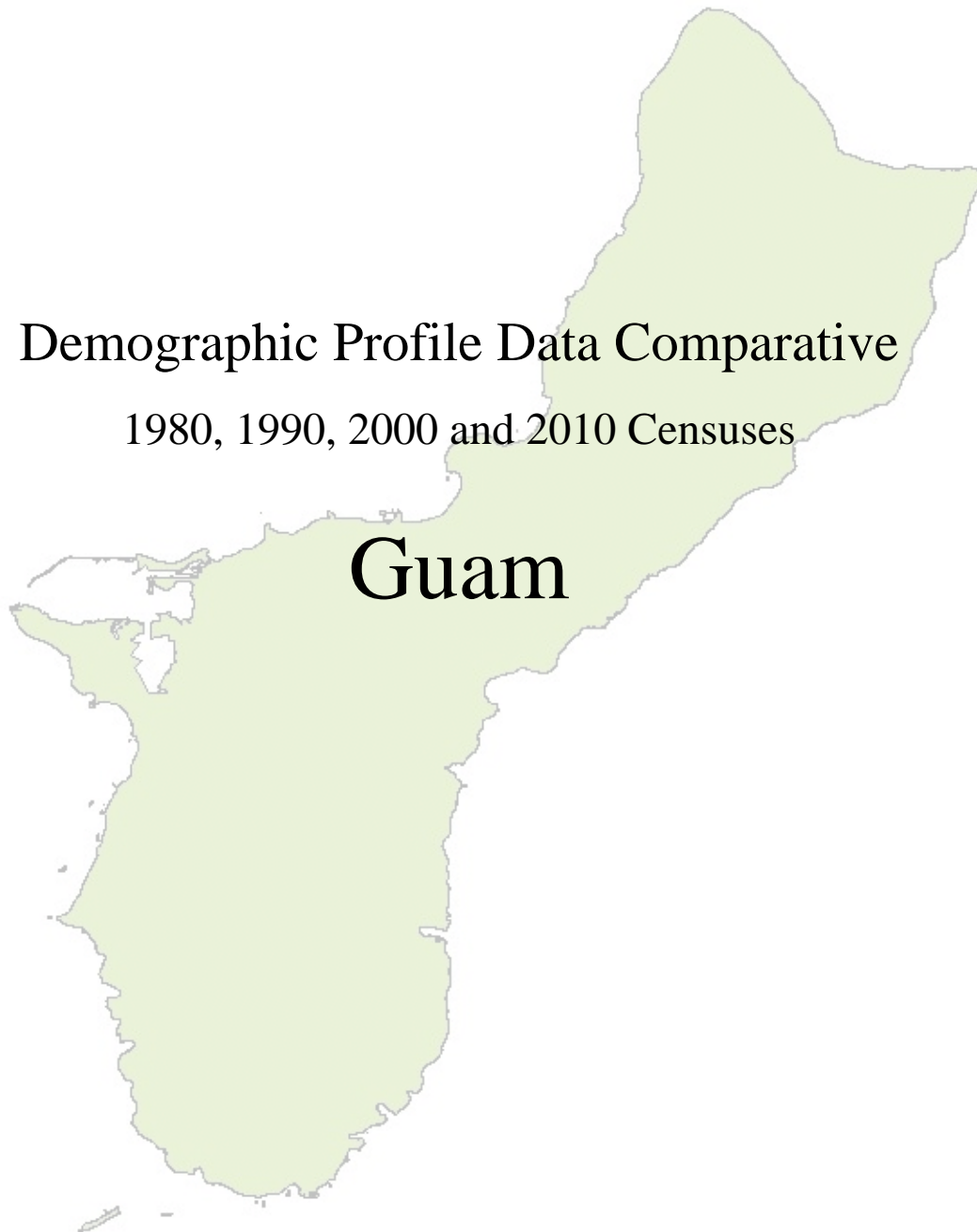

## Introduction

The Guam Demographic Profile Summary File contains data on population and housing subjects derived from questions on the 2010 Guam Census questionnaire. Data are presented in 86 population tables and 35 housing tables. Selected medians and means also are included. Each table has a two-character prefix followed by a sequential number.

The tables in this publication show data from the 1980, 1990, 2000 and 2010 Censuses to allow side-by-side comparisons for each of the data items in the 2010 Census Guam Demographic Profile Summary File for which comparable data is available.

**NOTE: Dollar amounts are for the year prior to the Census year, unless otherwise stated.**

# Chapter 3.

## Subject Locator

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### GENERAL INFORMATION

The Subject Locator is an index designed to quickly identify the tables (matrices) in the summary file. This index is arranged in alphabetical order by the name of a subject. Under each subject heading appears the universe or the type of entry being tabulated (shown in italics) and the relevant table number. Each variable is arranged alphabetically by universe, then by variable of cross tabulation, if any. If you are looking for a table tabulating age by sex for all persons, check the index under either of the two variables (“age” or “sex”). See the chapter, “List of Tables (Matrices)” for specific examples.
