SUBJECT: Federal Consistency Certification for UNDS Program for Phase II Batch Two Discharges (FC2019-0005)

Hafa Adai! The Bureau of Statistics and Plans is reviewing the enclosed Federal Consistency Certification (Subpart C) submitted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the Department of the Navy (DON) whom are applying for a Uniform National Discharge Standards (UNDS) for Vessels of the Armed Forces – Phase II Batch Discharges.

The UNDS-Phase II Batch Two discharge performance standards mirror, as appropriate, the EPA's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Vessel General Permits (VGP) (2013 VGP and 2014 Small VGP), which apply to commercial vessel discharges. While UNDS and VGP are separate actions, the VGP will inform you about the UNDS action, due to the similarities in the discharge performance standards

We respectfully request for your agency's review of the proposed project pursuant to Executive Order 78-37, Guam Land Use Policies and in accordance to your agencies/departments mandates.
