

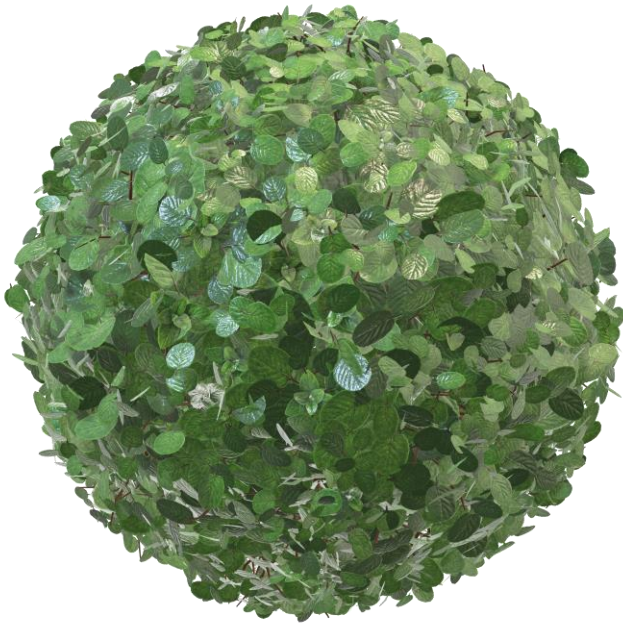

- optimum populations of organisms
- Balanced use of resources
- Maximum public use
- Avoidance of irreversible and irretrievable commitments of resources

Planning Principles

- **System Interrelations** systems communities, species, and their environment
- **Resource Function** living & nonliving, ensure system vitality long term
- **Sensitive Resources** of particular concern, various disturbances, under stress, rare, T&E, experienced damage
- **Sustainable Systems** primary consideration
