Furthermore, the Bureau's Guam Coastal Management program concurrence, objection, or notification of review status shall be sent to Dan's Marine Resort / Guam Bikini Island Club USACE.

PROJECT DISCRIPTION

The proposed structure will be made of materials that will be ordered prefabricated from an off-island source. It is approximately 40' feet wide and 80' feet long. The entire structure will consist entirely of materials made of stainless steel for the frame of the structure to include beams and columns with the roof attachments made up entirely of aluminum material. The proposed structure will be bolted together with stainless steel nuts and bolts. Manner of assembly and materials to be used in the construction of this structure is detailed in Exhibits A-D. All staff and materials will be transported by a large aluminum boat. Materials to be used:

- 1. Step ladders
- 2. Cordless power tools (for fastening nuts and bults)
- 3. Handheld tools (Hammers, wrenches, etc.)
- 4. Ropes and chains to help maneuver and hold beams and structural parts in place while bolting together
- Gloves and eyewear for safety.

PURPOSE OF THE EXPANSION PROJECT

The purpose of the expansion project is for, and not limited to providing a safe and dry resting area for our customers who would normally not be able to participate in our tours due to the sandbar being submerged. These customers are discouraged to participate for this simple reason. The customers concerned are the elderly, young children and infants as well as physically handicapped individuals who may be bound to a wheelchair or who use prosthetic limbs and or individuals who have other types of physical and or mental disabilities.

Assembly Process

As mentioned above the structure will be prefabricated and will be delivered directly to our office in Merizo, we will then offload the container and place all the structural parts onto a boat to be transported to the sandbar. We will then utilize all materials and staff to assemble the structure on the designated area which will take approximately 3-5 days.

Policy: Only those uses shall be located within the Seashore Reserve which:

- enhance, are compatible with or do not generally detract from the surrounding coastal area's aesthetic and environmental quality and beach accessibility; or
- can demonstrate dependence on such a location and the lack of feasible alternative sites.

Discussion:

the proposed structure will enhance the recreational value for disadvantaged customers such as but not limited to the elderly, young children and infants as well as handicapped individuals who normally will not be able to participate in our tours due to the sandbar being submerged.

Discussion: Due to the fact that there is no coral on the sandbar where the proposed structure will be

constructed, we are anticipating minimal impact to the surrounding natural marine habitat.

Policy: All living resources within the waters of Guam, particularly fish, shall be

protected from over harvesting and, in the case of corals, sea turtles and marine

mammals, from any taking whatsoever.

RP 5. Visual Quality

Intent: To protect the quality of Guam's natural scenic beauty

Policy: Preservation and enhancement of, and respect for the island's scenic resources

shall be encouraged through increased enforcement of and compliance with sign, litter, zoning, subdivision, building and related land-use laws. Visually objectionable uses shall be located to the maximum extent practicable so as not

to degrade significant views from scenic overlooks, highways and trails.

Discussion:

RP6. Recreation Areas

Intent: To encourage environmentally compatible recreational development.

Policy: The Government of Guam shall encourage development of varied types of

recreational facilities located and maintained so as to be compatible with the surrounding environment and land uses, adequately serve community centers and urban areas and protect beaches and such passive recreational areas as wildlife, marine conservation and marine protected areas, scenic overlooks,

parks, and historical sites.

Developments, activities and uses shall comply with the Guam Recreational

Water Use Management Plan (RWUMP).
