

17. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE
13.45326°N., 144.67131°E

Take Hwy 1 to Route 18 and turn west. Continue approximately 1.0 mile on Route 18 to the access road to Marianas Yacht Club and turn left (south). Continue 0.2-mile on the access road, and terrestrial portion of the park begins on right (west) side of road just before the yacht club entrance. The inflatable portion of the park is approximately 200-feet off-shore, and there is no developed access from the parking area to the shoreline yet.

18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)

Place several (7-8) large sandbag (structures) in shallow (~10-feet depth) marine waters approximately 200-feet off-shore to anchor/tether durable, inflatable structures within a 256-foot by 151-foot area.

Not requiring a Corps permit: construct structures (walkway, restrooms, staging area, etc) in uplands to provide access to inflatable recreational structures off-shore. Access from the existing road to other inland structures would be provided by constructing an elevated wooden walkway. (This is not within Corps jurisdiction, and this part of the project would not require a Corps permit).

Basic: Recreation

Provide a unique, contained, marine water-based recreational opportunity (inflatable ocean park) for residents and tourists in Guam.

No permanent structures - sand bags and inflatables can be removed as needed with minimal disturbance to the environment.

Project siting in near shore waters of Sasa Bay minimizes potential for impacting navigation.

Pre-project underwater surveys assist siting in sandy substrate and avoid coral and sea grass.

Use of divers during placement of sand bag anchors further minimizes potential for environmental impacts.
Inflatable park is designed to minimize footprint in aquatic resources, sand bags are the only impact on the sea floor.
