The Bureau of Statistics and Plans (Bureau) is in receipt of a Consistency Determination submitted by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) for its proposed Agat Mayor's Complex CAP 14 Emergency Shoreline Protection project. USACE's consistency determination involves the evaluation of the feasibility of emergency shoreline protection at the municipal headquarters in Agat. Hagåtña, Guam.
