THE "SEASHORE RESERVE"

A distinct and valuable natural resource belonging to all the people of Guam.



WHAT IS THE SEASHORE RESERVE?

“That land and water area of Guam extending seaward to the 10-fathom contour, including all islands within the Government’s jurisdiction except Cabras Island...and extending inland to the nearer of the following points:

- 1) From the MWHM for a distance on a horizontal plane of 10 meters.
- 2) From the MHWM to the inland edge of the nearest public right-of-way.”



SEASHORE RESERVE PLAN

Comprehensive, coordinated, enforceable plan for the conservation, management, and development of the seashore reserve.

Prepared in full consultation with:

- Governmental agencies and departments
- Private interests
- General public
