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- The Guåhan 2050 Sustainability Plan (G50SP) is a comprehensive framework aimed at guiding Guam towards a sustainable future by 2050.
- It emphasizes the importance of community engagement and integrates environmental, economic, and cultural considerations into decision-making.

What the Plan Is

- A commitment to the people of Guam, recognizing the long-term impact of development decisions.
- It envisions a future where vibrant communities, a strong economy, a healthy environment, and cultural heritage coexist harmoniously.
- The plan addresses challenges such as climate change, economic pressures, population growth, and cultural erosion.
- It is a land use policy framework that organizes interrelated policies to guide development and conservation efforts.

The Core Values of the Plan



- **Limits** – Respect ecological and infrastructure thresholds.
- **Balance** – Integrate environmental, economic, and cultural needs.
- **Renewal** – Revitalize the built environment; restore degraded lands, waters, and heritage.
- **Equity** – Ensure fairness in access to land, resources, and opportunity.
- **Engagement** – Include all voices in decisions and implementation.

The Thematic Goals of the Plan

- The plan is structured around five thematic goals:
 - Sustainable Communities,
 - Prosperous Economy,
 - Thriving Environment,
 - Vibrant Culture, and,
 - Village Sustainability.

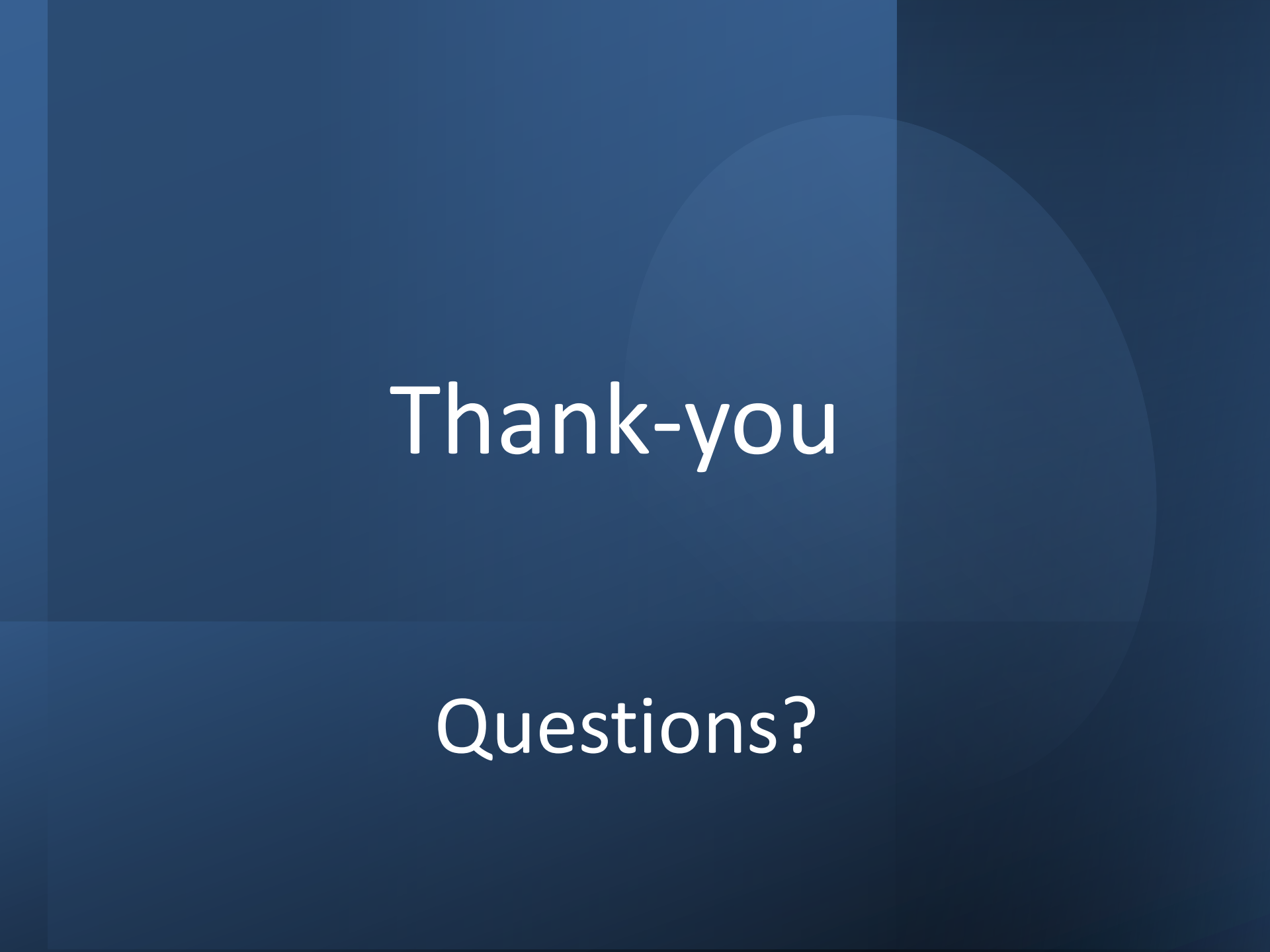
