This volume is the eight edition of the Annual Statistical Report prepared in a booklet, printed form. It contains data compiled from certificates registered with the Office of Vital Statistics (these certificates can be found on the back).

NATALITY: For the second consecutive years, live births have gone down slightly with a total of 3007 as compared to 3048 in 1976 and 3163 in 1975. The birth rate was 26.3 per 1,000 population.

Illegitimacy is still on the uprising. The illegitimate rate for the year was 164.6 per 1,000 live births.

The growth of the population due to natural increase (the excess of births over deaths) came to 2,627. The rate of natural increase was 23.0 per 1,000 population - 23.1 for 1976.

Premature births (5 pounds 8 ounces) or less totaled 231 or 7.7% of 3007 live births recorded for the year.

During 1977 a total of 20 babies had congenital malformation indicated on the birth certificate with a rate of 6.7 per 1,000 births

MORTALITY: A total of 380 deaths were registered which fell slightly as compared to 466 in 1976. The death rate is 3.3 per 1,000 population for 1977 and 4.2 in 1976.

The three top leading causes of death for the year were diseases of the heart, motor vehicle accidents and neoplasms. Diseases of the heart and neoplasm also ranked first and third respectively for 1976.

The percentage for male deaths was 63.9 as compared to 36.1 for female. The percentage for 1976 was 69.5 for male and 30.3 for female.

A total of 46 infant deaths were registered during the year with a rate of 15.3

The leading cause of death for infants under one year of age was congenital anomalies with 8 deaths. Respiratory distress syndrome ranked second with a total of 4 deaths.

Fetal deaths have gone up slightly with a rate of 17.6. The total for the year was 53 as compared to 44 in 1976.

MARRIAGES: A total of 1738 marriages were registered showing an increase of 200 from previous year.

The number of out marriages (the number of marriages where bride and groom were of different ethnic extraction) was 360 with a rate of 207.1

The percent for grooms who had never been married previously was 89.6 and 91.5 for brides. The proportion for grooms who had been divorced was 8.7% and 7.0% for brides.

March was the month with the highest number of marriages being performed with October and May following along.

DIVORCES: The 1977 divorce rate was 2.8 with a total of 315 and 16 annulments. It is still on the increase. The number of divorces has also increased every year in the nation.

Out of 331 divorces and annulments, 30.5% of males were of white extraction. Among females 35.3% were of Guamanian extraction.

Ten divorces accounted for one year duration of marriage and 64 with 20 years of marriage and over.

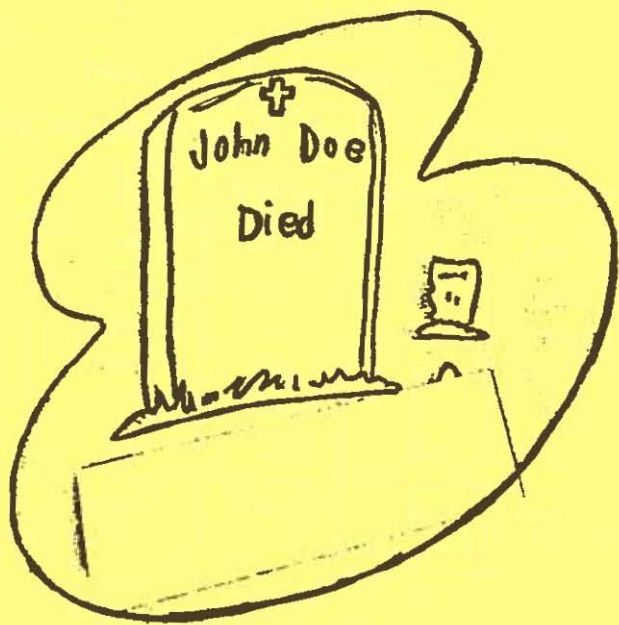

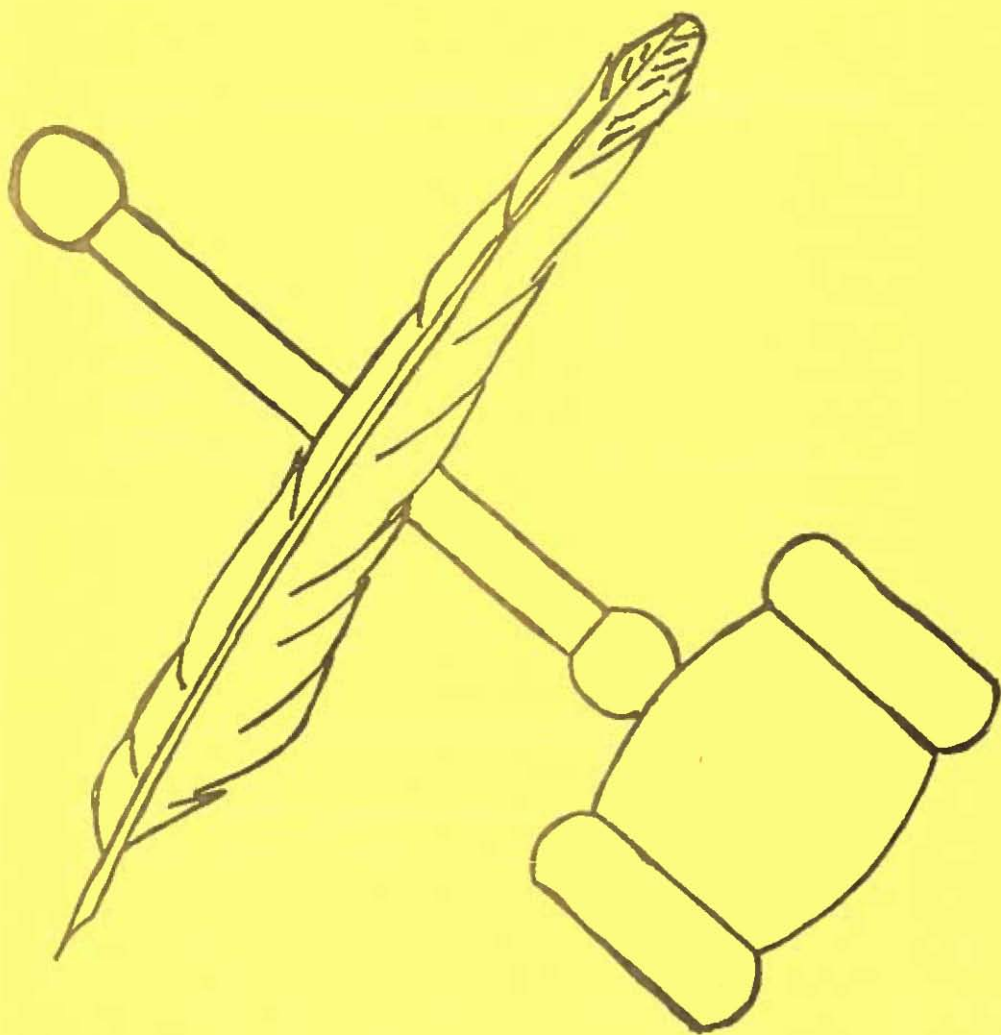

To detect crippled or potentially crippled children under 21 years of age residing on Guam; to provide a diagnostic evaluation and to provide appropriate medical or surgical treatment, hospitalization if necessary, and continuing care in order to promote maximum physical and mental capability of each child to function in a society. Criteria for eligibility for CCS coverage are geared toward providing maximum service within the bounds of available resources.

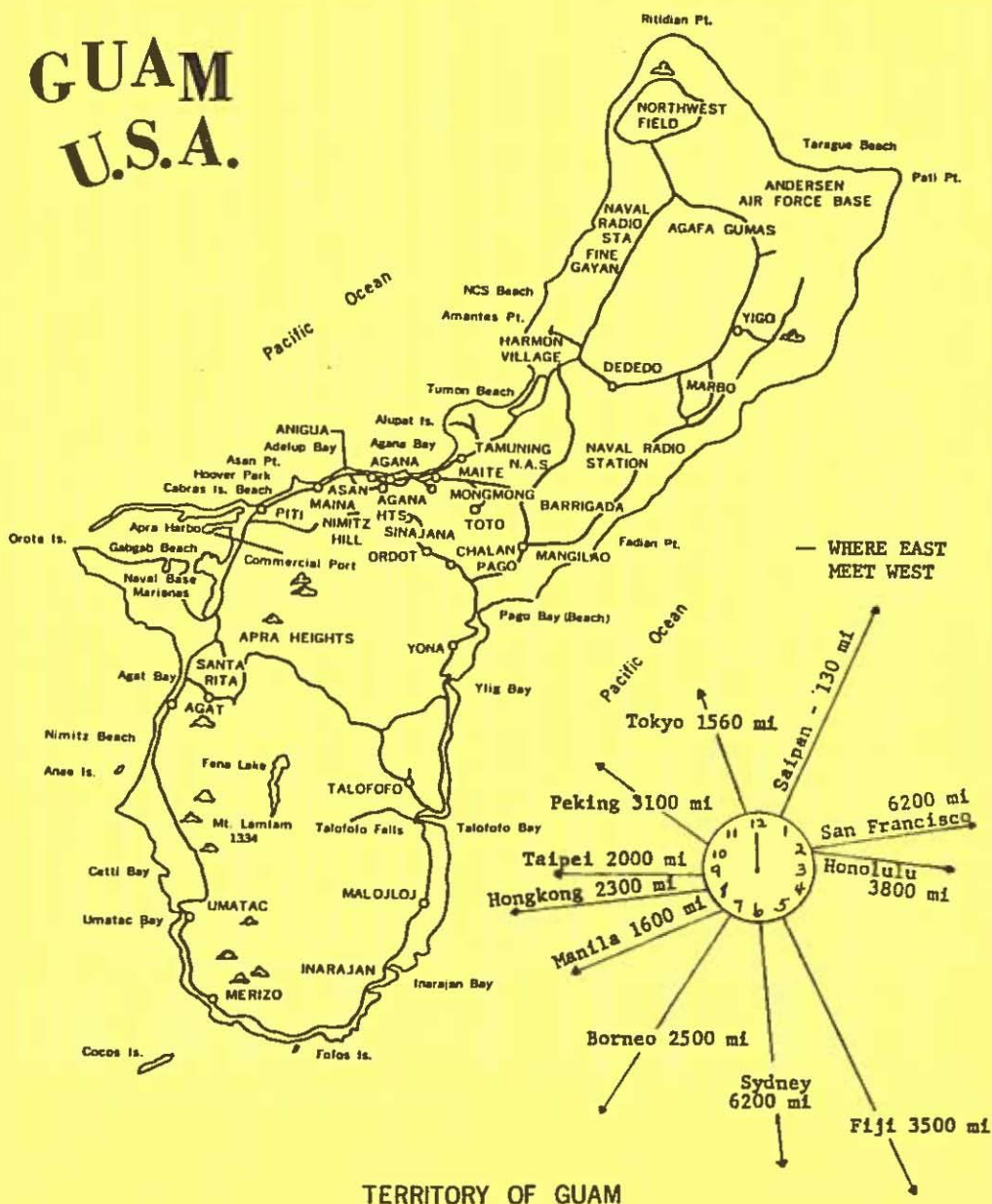
