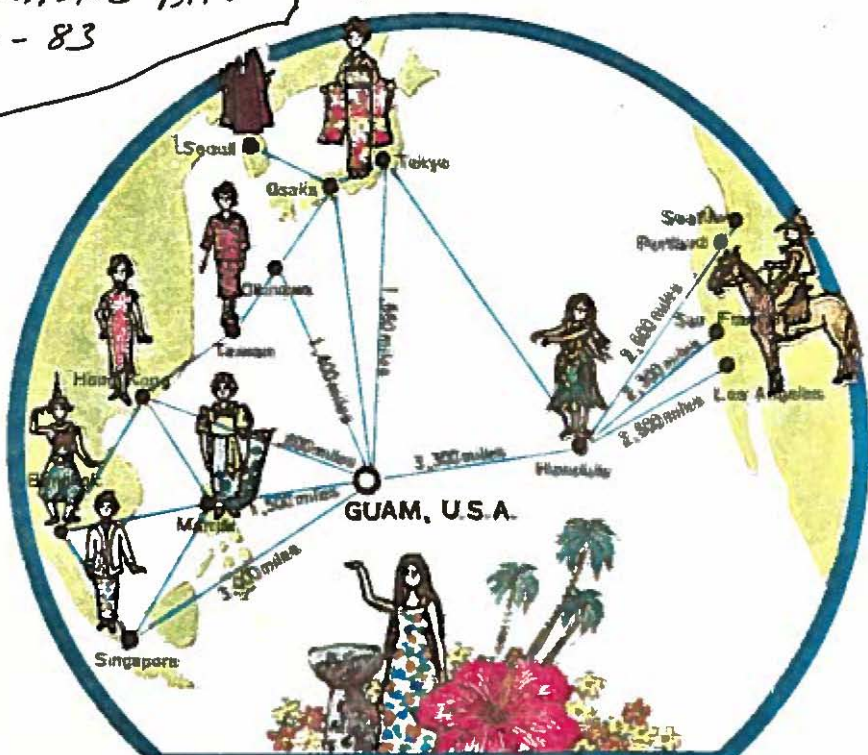

FOREWORD

This volume is the ninth edition of the Annual Statistical Report prepared in a booklet, printed form. It contains data compiled from certificates registered with the Office of Vital Statistics (these certificates can be found on the back).

NATALITY: There were 104 less live births in 1978 than there were in 1977. There were 2903 births for the year, the rate being 24.9 per 1,000 population. This is the fifth year in a row that a trend of decreasing births has shown.

Illegitimacy again is on the uprising with a total of 504 for the year.

Premature births (5 pounds 8 ounces or less) came to a total of 237 or 8.2% of 2903 live births.

A total of 28 babies had congenital malformation indicating on the birth certificate - showing a rate of 9.6 per 1,000 live births.

MORTALITY: There were 424 deaths registered for the year - a slight increase of 44 deaths as compared to 380 for 1977. The death rate was 3.6 per 1,000 population.

Heart disease has continued to be the number one cause of death, accounting for 21.2% of all deaths. It was followed by neoplasms, 9.9%; all other accidents with 6.6%. Homicide ranked fourth place with 28 cases.

The infant mortality rate of 15.8 per 1,000 live births was recorded in 1978.

MARRIAGES: There were 1769 marriages registered in 1978, an increase of about 31 over the 1977 figure. The most popular month for marriages was April with 185 followed by June.

The percent for grooms who had never been married previously was 87.5 and 89.4 for brides. The proportion for grooms who had been divorced was 10.9% and 8.6% for brides.

DIVORCES: There were 340 divorces granted in 1978. This represented a slight increase of 25 from previous year.

Out of 361 divorces and annulments, 31.3% of males were of white extraction. Among females, 29.4% were of Filipino extraction. Also, of the 361 divorces, 28.8% or 104 cases were without children under 18 years of age.

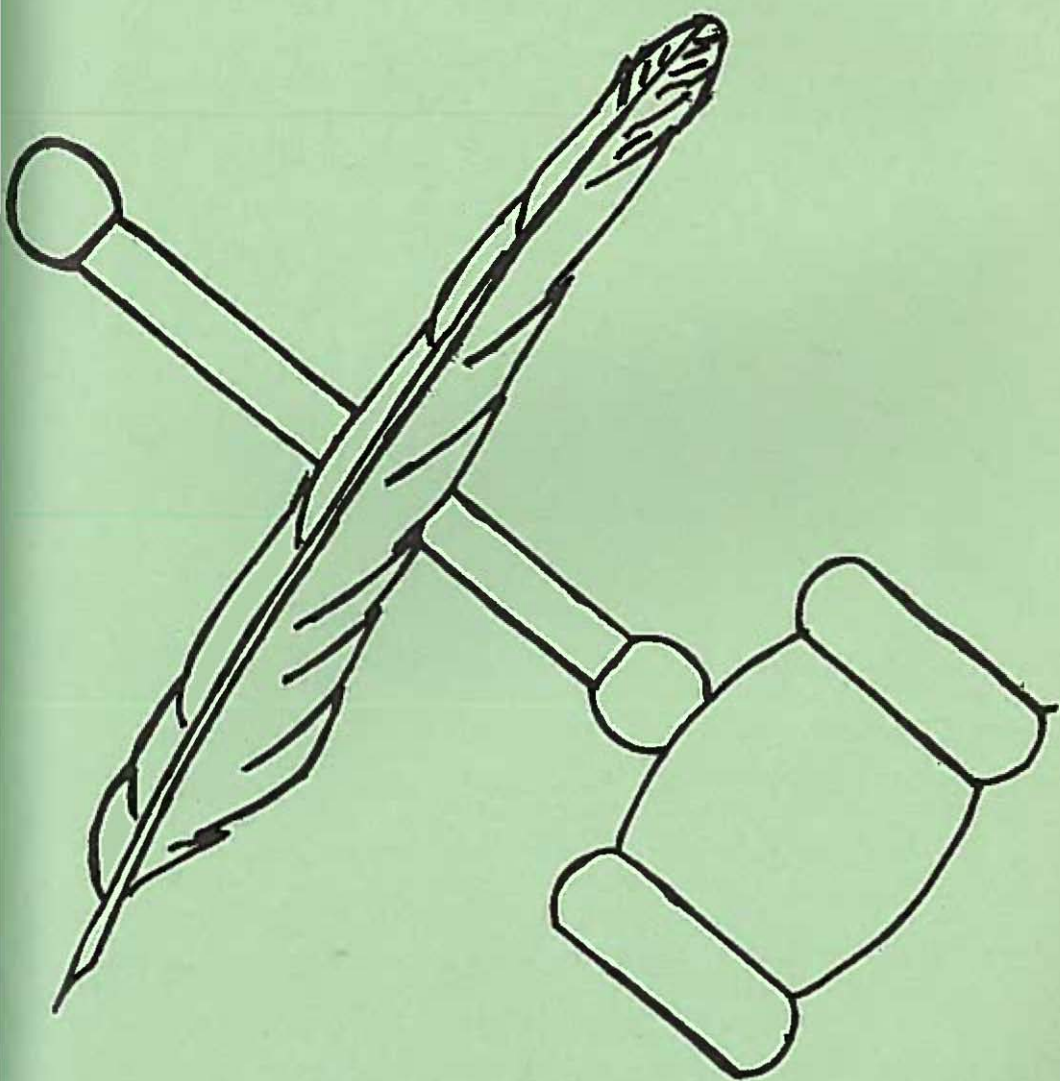

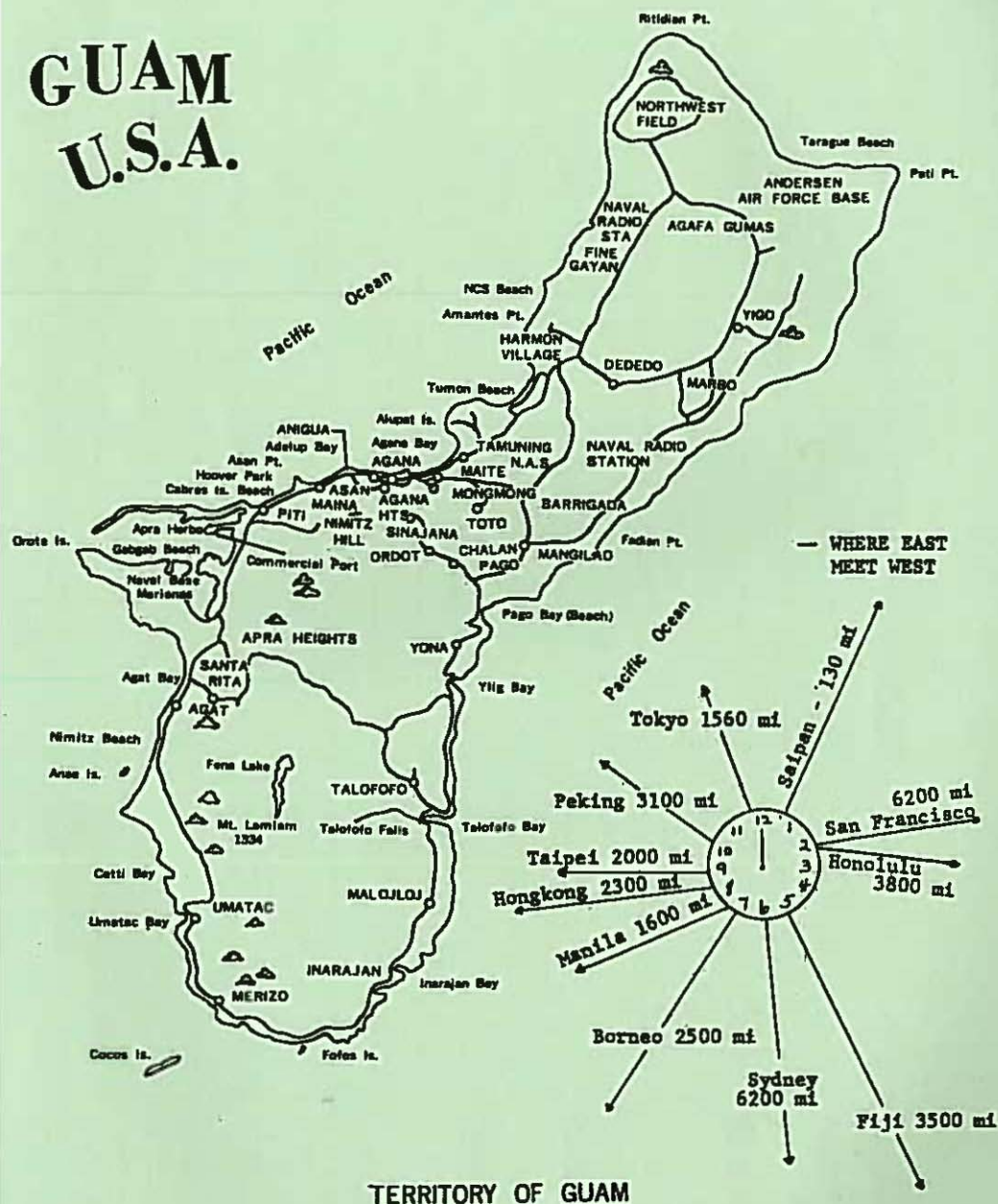
