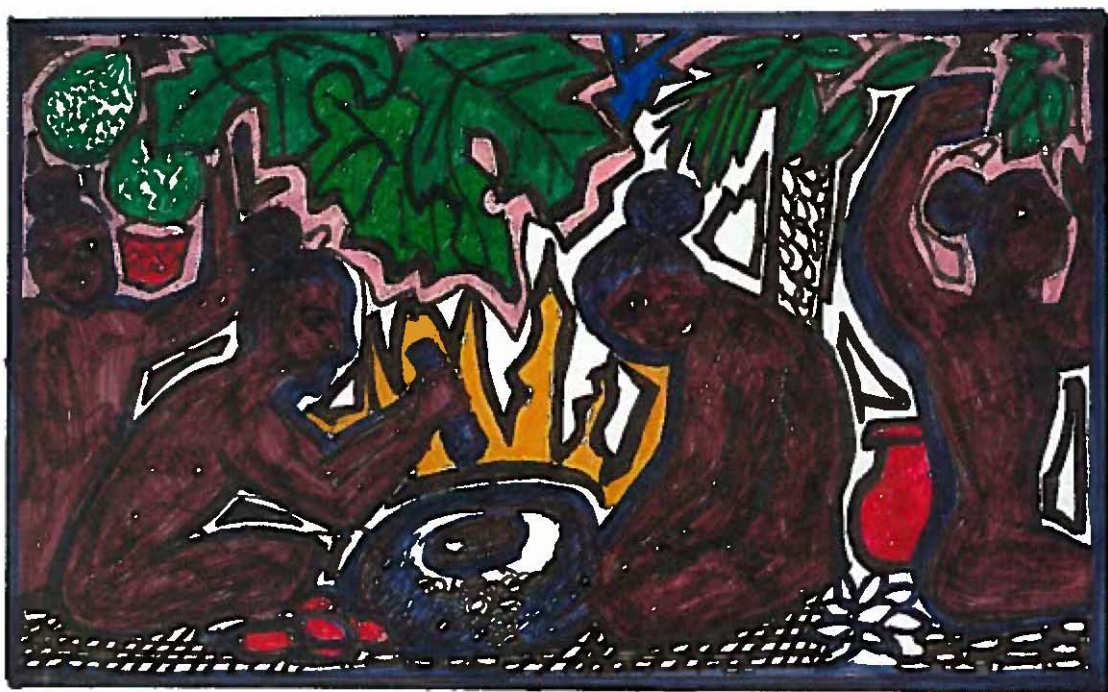

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FOREWORD

This volume is the 27th edition of the Annual Statistical Report prepared in booklet form.

The report, required under Section 3108 of 10 Government Code annotated, Chapter 3, shows data on Guam's births, deaths, infant and fetal deaths, marriages and divorces. It contains data compiled from certificates registered with the Office of Vital Statistics (these certificates can be found at the back). The time period is based on calendar year 1996.

Records received in this office from the hospitals are carefully reviewed for inconsistencies and are queried when necessary. Statistics are compiled annually for the report and other studies when registration is complete.

It is hoped that this report will be useful to health data users. It provides users with an overview of the health status of Guam's population. Questions and comments concerning data presented in this report should be directed to the Department of Public Health and Social Services, Office of Vital Statistics, P.O. Box 2816, Agana, Guam 96932.

In analyzing any data, the possibility of errors should not be overlooked. There are several types of errors, including errors by the informant as well as errors in processing and compilation. The most potentially dangerous error would be that of improper interpretation.

NATALITY - In 1996, 4,289 babies were born, an increase of 76 from 1995. The crude birth rate -- the number of births per 1,000 population -- was 27.5.

There were 4 live births to mothers under 15 years old and three to mothers 45 years old and over. Women aged 15 to 44 years were responsible for 99.8 percent of all live births for the year. Teenagers -- those under the age of 20 -- accounted for 530 births or 12.4 percent of all live births. The youngest mother giving birth in 1996 was 14 years old.

Out of a total of 4,289 live births, 64.9 percent were born to women receiving prenatal care in the first trimester. The percent of mothers beginning care during the second trimester was 22.3. The percentage of women giving birth and receiving no prenatal care was 6.2 percent.

Educational attainment of women varied with their age. Only 26.7 percent of mothers had less than a 12th grade education in 1996 compared to 22.5 percent in 1995. The proportion of mothers who had completed at least 4 years of college was 11.2 percent.

Birthweights of 5 pounds 8 ounces or less are defined as low birthweight births, an indicator of prematurity. In 1996, low birthweight births accounted for 7.2 percent of all births. The 59 low birthweight births to mothers between the ages of 15 and 19 was 1.4 percent of the births.

MORTALITY - The number of deaths occurring in 1996 came to a total of 627, an increase of 1 from 1995. The crude death rate was 4.0 per 1,000 population as compared to 4.1 for 1995.

A total of 273 individuals who died in 1996 had been married. The percent of females married at the time of death was 31.7 percent compared to 51.0 percent for males. The proportion who were widowed at the time of death was greater for women (38.3 percent) than for men (12.0 percent).

The top three causes of death for the year were (1) Diseases of the Heart, (2) Malignant Neoplasms and (3) Diabetes Mellitus. The ranking of the first and second causes has remained the same since 1978.

The total number of infant deaths on Guam was 38 in 1996. The Infant Mortality Rate was 8.9 per 1,000 live births. There were 45 fetal deaths with a rate of 10.4 per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths.

The year ended with 15 victims of homicide, 31 suicides and 20 motor vehicle deaths. These three causes of death occurred mainly among men -- 11 cases or 73.3 percent of all homicides, 28 suicides (90.3 percent) and 14 motor vehicle deaths (70.0 percent).

MARRIAGES - The year ended with 1514 marriages, 1 greater than 1995. The 1996 rate was 9.8 per 1,000 population.

The greatest number of marriages occurred between brides within the 20 to 24 year age group with 474 marriages (31.3 percent) and grooms within the 20 to 24 year age group with 441 marriages (29.1 percent).

In 1996, the age group 20 to 24 was the most common age group for first marriages for both brides and grooms.

DIVORCES - The number of divorces granted went down from 844 in 1995 to 783 in 1996, a decrease of 61 cases, showing a rate of 5.0 per 1,000 population. There were 24 annulments processed.

Out of the total 783 persons who were granted divorces and annulments, 597 (76.2 percent) were between the ages of 25 and 34.

Forty seven divorces and annulments, or 6.0 percent, were dissolved under one year of marriage.

SUMMARY

Definitions

Since this report uses various terms and technical connotations, it is necessary to define them to aid the reader in correctly interpreting the data. The following terms and notes are listed to help:

Birth Weight	Weight of fetus or infant at time of delivery.
Live Birth	The complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of human conception, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, which, after such expulsion or extraction, breathes or shows any other evidence of life such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord or definite movement of the voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached.
Gestational Period	Number of weeks elapsed between the first day of the last menstrual period and date of delivery.
Live-Birth Order	Order number is equal to number of previous live births plus current birth.
Low-Weight	Birth wherein the weight is equivalent to 2,500 grams or less (5 lbs. 8 ozs.), regardless of the period of gestation.
Fetal Deaths	Death prior to the complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of human conception, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy; the death is indicated by the fact that after such expulsion or extraction the fetus does not breathe or show any other evidence of life such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles.
Infant Death	Death occurring to an individual of less than one year of age.
Maternal Death	Death wherein the physician has designated maternal conditions as the underlying cause of death.
Neonatal Death	Death occurring to an infant less than 28 days of age.
Location	Place where the event actually occurred.
Natural Increase	The excess of births over deaths.
Perinatal Death	Neonatal deaths plus fetal deaths
Postneonatal Death	Death of a live born infant 28 to 364 days of age.
Underlying Cause of Death	That condition giving rise to the chain of events leading to death.

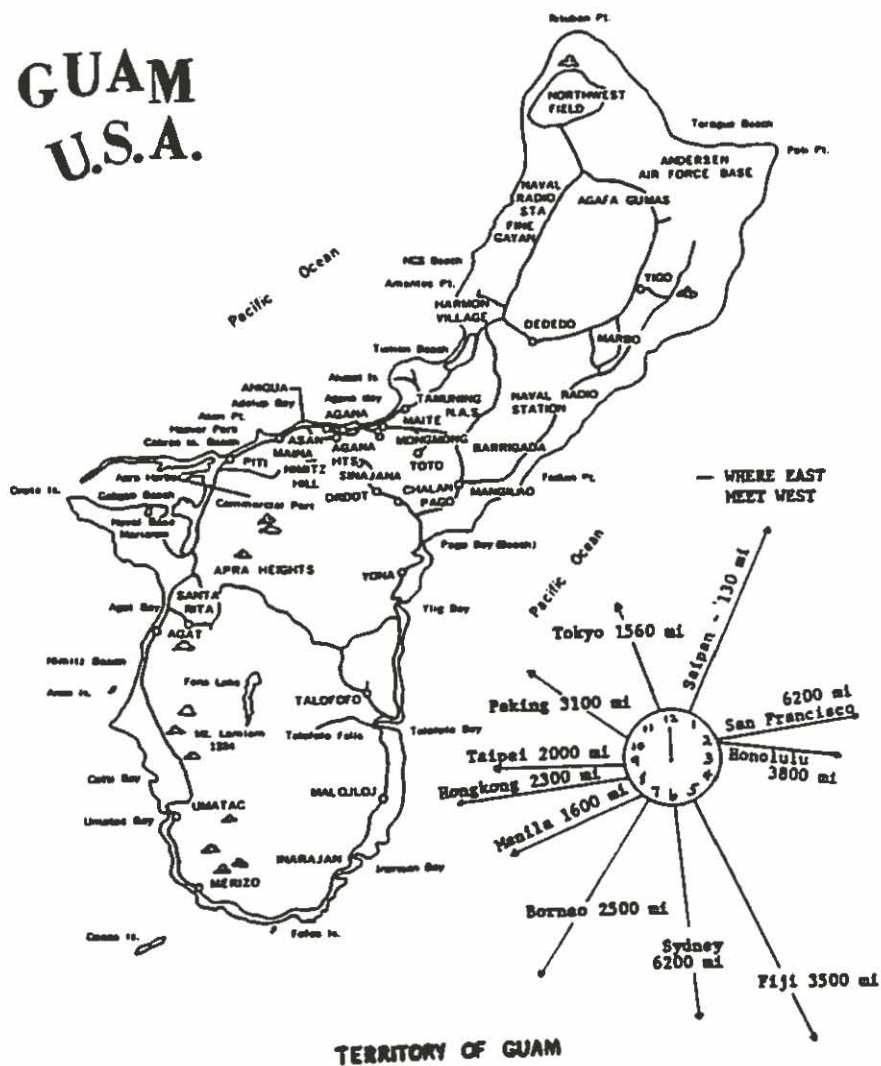

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Jose Ulloa Garrido was born in Ungaguan-Barrigada, Island of Guam, in 1944 to Vicente Pangelinan Garrido (Familian Kotla/Humatak) and Maria Acquiningoc Ulloa (Familian Matkos/Matcelo). A product of the Guam school system, Mr. Garrido attended Asan Elementary School and Cathedral Grade School between 1954 and 1959. In 1963, Mr. Garrido received his diploma from George Washington Senior High School. Immediately thereafter, from 1964 through 1967 this native son of Guam served in the United States Army. Choosing to further his education, in 1972, Mr. Garrido enrolled and completed his training program at the U.S. Naval Apprentice School. Realizing the benefits of dedication, hard work, and loyalty, Mr. Garrido retired from the U.S. Navy Public Works Center (PWC) after 30 years of service.

Despite the challenges facing Jose, he continued to be faithful to his love for the people, the island, the culture, the written and spoken language, the legends, the art of healing, but more importantly the ability to preserve and express the *Chamoru* heritage through art, poetry, and sculptures. Having no boundaries, Mr. Garrido's passion for life, prosperity, and peace is reflected by his interests as an industrial equipment mechanic, machinist, carpenter, mason, *Chamoru* traditional artist, sculptor, carver, free-lance self taught *Chamoru* historian, archeological study enthusiast, and *Chamoru* rights and land advocate.

Despite the hardship experienced by our ancestors, Mr. Garrido is optimistic that the *Chamoru* culture, customs, values, and norms will continue to thrive and once again engulf our entire being. As a people,
